Position Title: Assistant Coach

Position Description:

A Parks and Recreation Assistant Coach will work under the direction of the Coach, the Parks and Recreation Director and the Committee for the youth sport involved, and the established Volunteer policies and procedures. The overall function is to support the Coach as needed and to teach, encourage and support all children involved on your team.

Duties/Responsibilities:

The following are normal for this position:

- Assist the coach as needed or requested, and assume the duties of coach in his/her absence.
- A commitment to remain in this position for one season. If you find it impossible to continue, please give the Coach as much advance notice as possible, preferably at least two weeks.
- Attend as many worker-training meetings as possible. Treat your leadership as a trust and uphold the high ideals of the Parks and Recreation program.
- Encourage participation by all youth regardless of race, religion, color, sex, national origin, age or handicap.
- Maintain appropriate conduct befitting a person in a role model situation for youngsters.
- Retaining composure under pressure and handling conflict situations calmly is of the utmost importance.
